



Immigration Process Tips

The immigration application process is driven by documentation and attention to detail. Review the tips below and keep them in mind during the application process to ensure your case continues to move forward as fast as possible.

If these guidelines are not followed, additional time may be spent gathering and reviewing this information delaying the processing of your application.

Five Factors That Can Help Your Case

- 1 Fill out the questionnaire promptly.
- 2 Send in documents as soon as a case is opened and make sure they are up to date, expiration date is timely, etc.
- 3 Read and review the “Alerts” section in your case page to continually monitor the status of your applications.
- 4 Inform attorneys of critical deadlines in as far advance as possible.
- 5 Do not withhold sensitive information that may affect the case. Disclosing all relevant details up front will expedite the process and avoid complications.

Five Factors that Can Hurt or Delay Your Case

- 1 Not consulting an attorney(s) before traveling.
- 2 Relying on outside advice (e.g. websites, message boards) without verification from your attorney.
- 3 Overstating your years of experience/inflating resume or failing to fully disclose background and previous case history.
- 4 Not knowing when your current visa status expires.
- 5 Assuming your case covers everyone in your family.
